Study of “ Gekar Sinying “ under ‘Mission Amrit Sarovar - Jal Dharohar Sanrakshan’

Ministry of Housing Urban Affairs, GoI - Mission Amrit Sarovar - Jal Dharohar Sanrakshan Internship:

- MoHUA has identified 300+ culturally and historically significant water bodies across the country
- A mentor from the Archaeological Survey of India will be allocated for selected water bodies and will guide the student and faculty step-by-step procedure.
- **15 Students** from each institute assigned a nearby water body shall carry out the study, research & analysis of local water bodies
- **Institute may choose multiple water bodies; but for each water body separate INO and distinct 15 students must be assigned by the Institute. For Eg:- In case two water bodies selected by Institute, then two INO and 30 students must be allocated for the water bodies.**
- **Institute shall appoint 1 INO for each water body who shall be responsible for guiding the students and facilitating water body visits as well as ASI and ULB Nodal Officer coordination.**
- Application of knowledge in areas such as **Urban Planning, Architecture, Urban Design, Engineering, and Fine Arts**
- The duration of the internship shall be from **14th July 2022 to 5th August 2022**
- AICTE shall transfer a total sum of **2 lakh to institutes**, in two installments of Rs. 1 lakh each prior and Rs. 1 lakh on completion of the activities.
- Rs 20,000 released at the internship start to cover travel, project materials costs etc.
- Disbursement of **the stipend of Rs. 10,000/student** for all participating students
- **Rs. 30,000 shall be paid to Institute Nodal Officer /Institution Faculty who shall mentor & support interns**
- Poster submissions shall be reviewed by a committee of MoHUA appointed experts – **Best 25 entries will receive a cash award of Rs. 10,000 per team.**
- The Best 10 entries will also receive a Citation.
- Tweeted/Uploaded photographs shall be adjudged and **Best 25 photo entries shall receive a cash prize of Rs. 10,000**

- Stipend of Rs.10,000 per Student to 15 Students
- Certificate from AICTE and Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, GoI
- Opportunity to involve in live project
- Participate in National Mission Project.
